**Peer Education Mentor - Youth Outreach Worker (2 positions available)**

ResQ Youth International is a registered charity providing services to racialized and marginalized youth through counselling, student mediation/advocacy, restorative justice, life skills/character building training and career coaching/job search programs for over 18 years.

**Type of Position: Temporary Canada Summer Job. 35 hours per week. For 8 weeks.**

**Position Summary:**

**All requirements of the position will be carried out following the public health guidelines for Covid 19. The majority of the work will be done remotely.**

The Peer Education Mentor — Youth Outreach Worker will, after consultations with school personnel, meet virtually with students including those who will be de-streamed. The PEM will assist in preparing them for their educational integration into inclusive classes. The YOW will act as educational peer mentor and advocate. The PEM will provide remote meetings, workshops, and training for youth. The PEM will act as a liaison between youth and other youth-serving agencies.

We are seeking, preferably, a university/college student. Must be registered as a full-time student and will be returning to school in September.

**Skills/Knowledge Required:**

A significant proportion of this work will be done remotely. The applicant will need to be an effective communicator through video/conferencing.

- The Peer Education Mentor - Youth Outreach Worker should be studying in a related discipline such as Social Work, Child and Youth Work, Community Work, Teaching, etc.
- The PEM should be outgoing, articulate and willing to initiate conversations with youth.
- The PEM is expected to have a strong understanding of the specialized needs of Youth with knowledge of and sensitivity to their life experiences.
- should have or acquire knowledge of local programs and services for Black youth.
- The PEM should be able to work well independently as well as part of a team.
- Knowledge and familiarity with patois, Caribbean dialects, or creole is a benefit.

Must be between the ages of 15 – 30 years old and legally entitled to work in Canada.
